

Validation of the Introduction

Items to validate in the introduction

Yes or No

It situates the research.

It presents the objectives of the text.

It presents the divisions of the text.

It attracts the reader's attention.

It prepares the reader for the content that is coming.

It introduces the subject and presents it in a general context.

The initial idea of the subject introduced is directly related to the subject treated.

It states the subject and specifies the aim of the research.

The stated subject transforms the object of the study into questions to be solved.

It specifies who is (are) the person (people) addressed.

It announces the plan (the broad outline of the work).

The subject stated announces the order in which the parts will be developed.

The subject introduced, the subject stated and the subject divided form a whole whose parts are related.
