

## Java error in Cégep à distance courses for Mac

The new Java version 7 update 51 uses stricter security conditions. If you cannot see the tabs in your courses, or if you are getting this error message:



you will have to change your Java settings.

- Please note that if your OS X is higher than 10.7.3, you will have to do the Java update manually by going to <http://www.java.com>.


- We recommend that you use Firefox or Chrome rather than Safari for your Cégep à distance courses. You can download these browsers from:

Go to "System Preferences" from the Apple icon.




Cont'd...

Click on the Java icon.

In the "Security" tab, click the "Edit Site List" button.



Cont'd...


Click "Add" and enter <http://www.cegepadistance.ca>.

Click OK to confirm all your choices. Restart your browser and accept the Java security messages from the Cégep à distance website.
